As a Wisconsin physician, Doctor Day is the best way for you to

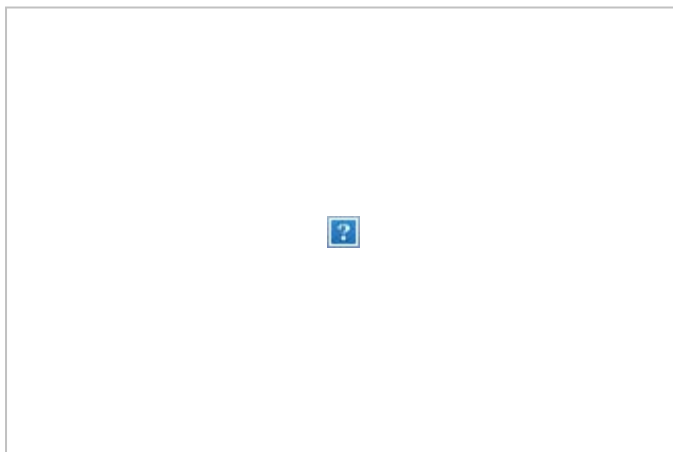

## IPFCF fees unchanged for 2019-2020

There will be no change in fees for the Injured Patients and Families Compensation Fund for the 2019-2020 fiscal year.

The Fund's board of governors voted to keep fees the same during its recent meeting, pending review and expansion of risk classifications to mirror the primary medical liability market and practice complexity. Classification changes will likely be implemented during the next legislative biennium, according to Linda Syth, who is one of two Society representatives on the Fund's board.
