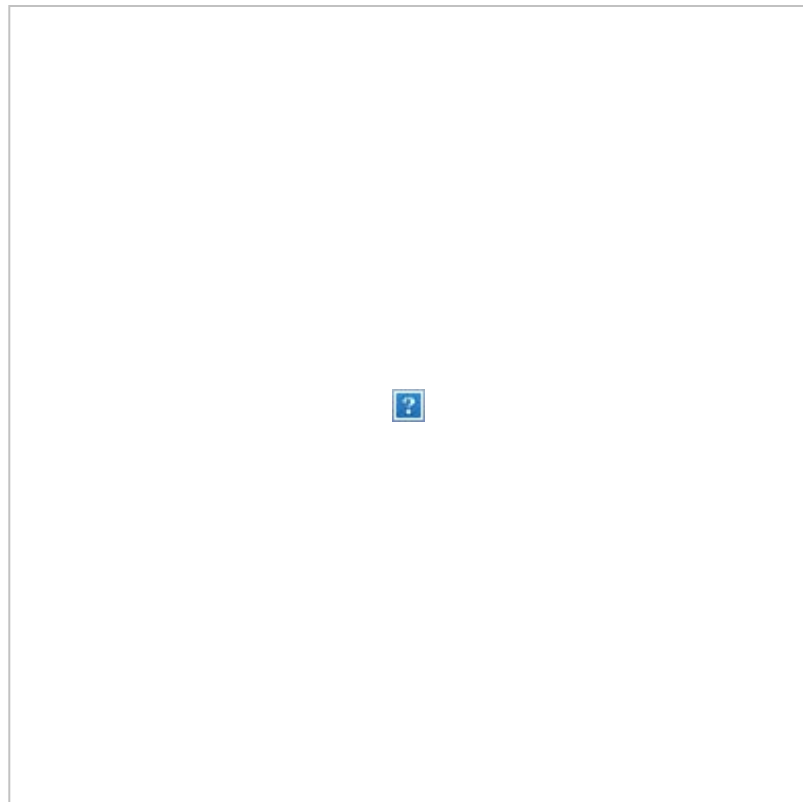

Great Turnout for Doctor Day

Doctor Day 2019 brought more than 300 physicians and medical students from across the state to Madison to meet with legislators and their staffs yesterday. Key issues included vaccines and the "personal conviction" exception to school vaccination law as well as ensuring access to important Medicaid services by addressing historically low physician reimbursement rates.



Prior to meeting with legislators at the State Capitol, attendees heard from two speakers: Wisconsin Gov. Tony Evers and Department of Health Services Secretary Andrea Palm. Gov. Evers, who was introduced by his daughter Erin Schoenecker, MD, praised physicians for the care they provide and asked for their help in ensuring access to care.

Free Buprenorphine X-Waiver Training Series

DHS has partnered with the Wisconsin Society of Addiction Medicine to increase treatment capacity for opioid use disorder through expanded prescribing of buprenorphine, one of three Food and Drug Administration (FDA)-approved medications for the treatment of opioid use disorder.

Ten in-person training sessions for health care providers eligible to prescribe buprenorphine are scheduled across Wisconsin this year. Each session, when paired with an online session offered through the American Society of Addiction Medicine, provides the necessary education for participants to qualify for a waiver to prescribe buprenorphine as part of a medication-assisted treatment plan for opioid dependency.
